On occasion multi-shot cakes will tip over during the firing process. Placing the cake in the grass or on an uneven surface will significantly increase the chance of a cake tipping over. This can result in injury or property damage. Please follow the warning label/instructions provided by the manufacturer. In addition to following the manufacturer instructions, we highly recommend bracing all multi-shot cakes by using the following methods:



Stake Down The Cake Using Wooden Stakes On At Least Two Sides And Secure With Duct Tape.



Secure The Cake Using Heavy Bricks, Concrete Blocks, Or Large Heavy Objects <u>On All Four Sides.</u>

All fireworks sold by Xtreme Fireworks meet all State and Federal safety regulations and are of the highest quality. However, using fireworks in an unsafe manner could result in serious injury or even death. Xtreme Fireworks recommends the following:

- * Never allow young children to play with or ignite fireworks. Always have an adult supervise fireworks activities. Parents don't realize that young children suffer injuries from sparklers. Sparklers burn at temperatures of about 2,000 degrees hot enough to melt some metals.
- * Never place any part of your body directly over a fireworks device when lighting the fuse. Back up to a safe distance immediately after lighting fireworks.
- * Never try to re-light or pick up fireworks that have not ignited fully.
- * Never point or throw fireworks at another person. NEVER light fireworks in your hands.
- * Light fireworks one at a time, then move back quickly.
- * Never carry fireworks in a pocket or shoot them off in metal or glass containers.
- * Do not store fireworks in close proximity to a heat source. Have water close by to prevent fires.
- * Do NOT hold Roman candles! Backfiring or side blowouts can cause serious burns and eye injuries.
- * Carefully follow/read ALL safety labels/instructions before using fireworks.
